# Robert II de Beaumont, 2nd Earl of Leicester1 b. 1104, d. 1168;

Robert II de Beaumont, 2nd Earl of Leicester was born in 1104 at Leicester, Leicestershire, England. He was the son of Robert I de Beaumont-le-Roger, 1st Earl of Leicester and Isabel de Vermandois. 2nd Earl of Leicester at England between 5 June 1118 and 1168.2,3 Robert II de Beaumont, 2nd Earl of Leicester married Amice de Montfort, daughter of seigneur de Montfort Ralph de Gaël, after 25 November 1120 at Brittany, France.4 Robert II de Beaumont, 2nd Earl of Leicester was knighted in 1122. The Charter to Salisbury, by King Henry I. In attendance 5 Earls: Chester, Gloucester, Surry, Leicester, and Warwick. On 8 September 1131 at Northampton, England.5 He was one of the 5 Earls who witnessed the Charter to Salisbury granted at the Northampton Council of Henry I on 8 September 1131 at Northampton, England.5 He was a staunch adherant of Henry I before 1135. He witnessed the death of Henri I "Beauclerc", roi d' Angleterre on 1 December 1135 at Castle of Lihun, Rouen, Normandy.6,7 Robert II de Beaumont, 2nd Earl of Leicester was appointed Justiciar of England on the accession of Henry II to the throne in 1155.8 Justiciar of England between 1155 and 1168.8 He died in 1168 at England at age 64 years.9

Also called Robert Harcourt. Robert III de Beaumont, 3rd Earl of Leicester was born circa 1121 at Beamont, France. He was the son of Robert II de Beaumont, 2nd Earl of Leicester and Amice de Montfort. Robert III de Beaumont, 3rd Earl of Leicester married Petronilla de Grentesmesnil, daughter of Hugh II de Grentesmesnil of Hinkley. Earl of Leicester at England between 1168 and 1190.2 The Great Rebellion: Henry II versus his heir, Henry "the Young King", his two older brothers, the Earl of Leicester, the King of Scots, the King of France, and the Count of Flanders. In 1172/73 at 19 Henry II.3,4 Robert III de Beaumont, 3rd Earl of Leicester incited an insurrection against Henry II in support of the king's son (whom Henry himself had crowned) Henry "the Young King" in 1172/73 at 19 Henry II.5 (1172/73) Was a witness where Hugh le Bigod, 1st Earl of Norfolk in the 19 Henry II, sided, all the favor of Henry II notwithstanding, with Robert, Earl of Leicester, (the husband of his cousin, Petronilla) in the insurrection incited by that nobleman in favor of the king's son (whom Henry himself had crowned) Henry "the Young King." 5 Robert III de Beaumont, 3rd Earl of Leicester was a witness where Henri "the Young King" d' Anjou fomented the Great Rebellion against his father with his two older brothers, the King of France, and the Count of Flanders, in 1172/73 at 19 Henry II.3 Robert III de Beaumont, 3rd Earl of Leicester was was a crusader in 1179. He died in 1190 at Durazzo Provence, West Albania.6

He was the son of Louis de Brienne, vicomte de Beaumont and Agnès de Beaumont. Arms: Azure semy of fleurs-de-lis and a lion rampant or surmounted by a bend compony argent and gules.3,4 Henry, 1st Lord Beaumont was with the forces of Edward I at the capture of the castle of Stirling, a victory for the English, between 22 April 1304 and 20 July 1304 at the Siege of Castle Stirling.5 He was was made knight in 1308. He was was a Member of Parliment between 1308 and 1332. He was created Lord Beaumont by his 2nd cousin, King Edward II, in 1309.6,7 1st Lord Beaumont between 1309 and 1340.2,8 He married Alice Comyn, daughter of Sir Alexander Comyn and Joan le Latimer, before 14 July 1310.8 Henry, 1st Lord Beaumont was presumably created Earl of Moray by Edward Baliol during the brief period when, as King of Scotland, he had the right to confer the Earldom in 1332?.7 4th Earl of Moray at Scotland between 1332 and 1338.7 He was summoned to the English Parliament as Earl of Buchan in 1334.7 Earl of Buchan at Scotland between 1334 and 1338.8,7 Justicair of Scotland in 1338. He died on 10 March 1340.
